Ken and Georgia Frawley established 4 Parents and Teaches to provide quality children's and family music, video, movement, and American Sign Language (ASL) products to children, families and educators working with young children.

Ken Frawley is a nationally known performer, songwriter of music for children, author, and professional trick roper. His career has been based on providing fun, entertaining, and educational material and programs to children while providing parents, teachers, and early childhood professionals skills so they can use music, movement, and American Sign Language, ASL, effectively with children.

Georgia Frawley, MA, has been teaching high school classes in Child Development, Marriage and Family, Parenting, Physical Education and Careers with Children for over 35 years.

Together, Ken and Georgia present across the U. S. on how to use American Sign Language (ASL) with children (babies through elementary) to provide for early communication, learning, language enhancement and fun. They began using sign language for communication and learning over 40 years ago with their own children and later combined ASL with music for their concerts. They then co-produced the *We Sign* DVD series, receiving over 50 national awards, and co-authored the Mom's Choice award winning *Sign to Speak: Babies Can Talk* and *Sign to Speak: Toddlers at Play* books.
